

Easter is the highlight of our Christian celebrations

Through Lent we prepare to appreciate our faith more deeply

Throughout Lent we will be working towards the joy of Easter Day through a variety of events around the theme of Holy Communion (The Eucharist). We have chosen this theme because many people have expressed an interest in understanding more about the words and meaning of the Holy Communion service. There will be various opportunities to participate and you will be very welcome at any or all of them.

To explore this theme we will be following the Church of England Pilgrim course on The Eucharist. We have already studied other Pilgrim courses at St. Mary's and found them to be very insightful and enjoyable.

There is a diary within this leaflet that identifies a theme for each week. Every Sunday will have an address that begins the exploration. During the week there will be two Bible Study Groups. One run by Chris and Rachel Archer in their home and one by Ruth Peet in the Front Room of Church House. There is a midweek service of Holy Communion that will be quiet and reflective. There is also an ecumenical dimension with a Lent Course on a selection of Psalms run by Churches Together and a Lent Lecture called God and Stress both held at St. John's Church, Park Road, Bromley.

Holy Week will have a familiar pattern with a few innovations. Maundy Thursday will have two celebrations one of a Messy Church feel and one of a quiet and reflective feel. Please join us for the March of Witness in central Bromley on Good Friday in the morning. In the afternoon there will be again a choice which begins with a devotional Hour at the Cross followed by a creative and participative Hot Cross Bun service. The choir will accompany many of our services and give two delightful choral services; one on Palm Sunday and one on Good Friday.

Our culmination will be on Easter Sunday when we will celebrate the resurrection of Jesus and bring our reflections on the Holy Communion to a conclusion as we see how God is so wonderfully at work among us.
