Prayers of Penitence

Invitation to Confession

A voice cries out in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord.' So let us listen, and turn to the Lord in penitence and faith.

All Lord, have mercy.

You come in word and sacrament to strengthen us in holiness: Christ, have mercy.

The reader announces The Gospel: Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to N.

All Glory to you, O Lord.

At the end This is the Gospel of the Lord. All Praise to you, O Christ.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

All We believe and trust in him. Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

All We believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

- All We believe and trust in him. This is the faith of the Church.
- All This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.
