We have recently heard that a recommendation has been made to the Church Buildings Council to grant us £5,000. Another £5,000 bid has also been submitted to the William and Jane Morris Fund. An engineer attended in July and carried out a pressure test on the boiler. This revealed a leak which was rectified with some new components.
